On January 1, 2001, WP&L, including South Beloit, transferred its transmission assets with no gain or loss (approximate net book value of \$186 million) to ATC LLC. WP&L received a tax-free cash distribution of \$75 million from ATC LLC and had a \$110 million equity investment in ATC LLC. WPL Transco

LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of WP&L, holds the investment in ATC LLC and follows the equity method of accounting.
