- (1) Of the 89,766 shares acquired pursuant to the employee stock option exercise reported above, approximately 60,194 shares were sold to cover the cost of exercise and withholding taxes. Mr. Schick retained 50% of the net shares acquired from this option exercise.

These shares were sold in multiple transactions at prices ranging from \$49.67 to \$49.75.
