(1) Each share of Class A Common Stock was issued upon conversion of one share of Class B Common Stock.

Each share of Class B Common Stock is convertible at any time at the option of the holder into one share of Class A Common Stock. In addition, each share of Class B Common Stock will convert automatically into one share of Class A Common Stock upon any transfer, whether or not for value and whether voluntary or involuntary or by operation of law, except for certain transfers described in the Issuer's Amended and Restated Certificate of Incorporation, including, without limitation, certain transfers for tax and estate planning purposes.

(3) The Reporting Person is a manager of NEA 11 GP, LLC, which is the sole general partner of NEA Partners 11, Limited Partnership ("NEA Partners 11"). NEA Partners 11 is the sole general partner of New Enterprise Associates 11, Limited Partnership ("NEA 11"), the direct beneficial owner of the Shares. The Reporting Person disclaims beneficial ownership within the meaning of Section 16 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended, or otherwise of such portion of the shares held by NEA 11 in which the Reporting Person has no pecuniary interest.

(4) NEA 11 made a pro rata distribution for no consideration of an aggregate of 1,607,096 shares of Class A Common Stock of the Issuer to its general partner and its limited partners on March 4, 2014.

(5) NEA Partners 11 received 493,378 shares of Class A Common Stock of the Issuer in the distribution by NEA 11 on March 4, 2014.

(6) The Reporting Person is a manager of NEA 11 GP, LLC, the sole general partner of NEA Partners 11, the direct beneficial owner of the Shares. The Reporting Person disclaims beneficial ownership within the meaning of Section 16 of the 1934 Act, as amended, or otherwise of such portion of the shares of Class A Common Stock held by NEA Partners 11 in which the Reporting Person has no pecuniary interest.

(7) NEA Partners 11 made a pro rata distribution for no consideration of an aggregate of 493,378 shares of Class A Common Stock of the Issuer to its limited partners on March 4, 2014.

(8) PJ Barris, LLC received 32,065 shares of Class A Common Stock of the Issuer in the distribution by NEA Partners 11 on March 4, 2014.

(9) The Reporting Person is a member of PJ Barris, LLC, which is the direct beneficial owner of the Shares. The Reporting Person disclaims beneficial ownership within the meaning of Section 16 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended, or otherwise of such portion of the shares of Class A Common Stock of the Issuer held by PJ Barris, LLC in which the Reporting Person has no pecuniary interest.
