Passeri, the chief executive officer of the Company, entered into a letter agreement effective as of December 31, 2013 (the Letter Agreement), pursuant to which the parties mutually agreed to extend the term of Mr. Passeri's employment agreement dated as of September 18, 2007, as amended October 27, 2008, December 16, 2010 and January 18, 2013, until December 31, 2014.
