On March 22, 2018, CatchMark Timber Trust, Inc. ( Catchmark ) issued a press release announcing that the underwriters in CatchMark s previously-announced public offering exercised in full the over-allotment option granted to the underwriters with respect to the purchase of an additional 750,000 shares of Class A common stock at a public offering price of \$12.60 per share. The over-allotment option was exercised in connection with CatchMark s previously announced underwritten public offering of 5,000,000 shares of Class A common stock. As a result of the exercise of the over-allotment option, the total gross proceeds from the offering are approximately \$72,450,000 before deducting the underwriting discount and other estimated offering expenses.
