On June 16, 2011, Cardtronics, Inc. filed a Form 8-K summarizing the matters voted on at its annual meeting of shareholders held on June 15, 2011 (the "Original Report"). Such annual voting shall continue until Cardtronics submits to its shareholders another non-binding advisory vote on the frequency of holding advisory votes on named executive officer compensation.

This Current Report on Form 8-K/A amends the Original Report solely for the purpose of disclosing Cardtronics' decision regarding the frequency of the advisory vote on the compensation of their named executive officers.
